

MUSICAL THEATRE PROGRAM

BEHAVIOUR & APPROPRIATE DEPORTMENT EXPECTATIONS:

- If a student is disruptive during class, they will have the opportunity to calm down and re-focus into the class activity after consulting with an instructor.
- If this student does not respond in an appropriate manner and continues to be a distraction to class activities, said student will be removed from the classroom to sit out, until they are ready to participate again with 100% attentiveness. This will count as an infraction or a *strike*.
- 4 After class is finished for the day, Program Director will contact said child's parents and informed them of the 1st strike / infraction.
- → We will operate on the "3 strikes, you're out" method of dealing with disruptive behavior. After 3 strikes, you will be suspended from the program for a designated number of classes, your parent will be phoned and you'll be sent home on the spot. If this inappropriate behavior persists, you will be asked to leave the program.
- If one student leaves the studio without being excused, or storms out, this will also count as a *strike*. Other students must not follow that person out of the room. If they do, they will earn a *strike* as well.
- 4 There will be **no** Cellphone use in the studio. Cellphones, iPhones, etc. are to be shut OFF at the start of the class.
- **↓** Tantrums will not be tolerated. You must conduct yourselves as mature young adults.
- ♣ Please do not be judgmental or competitive with your fellow students. Concentrate on your own strengths and challenges.
- ♣ You will occasionally be asked to work with specific scene partners or groups during the course of the year. It is very important to be respectful and compliant in this regard; especially if your spouse/partner happens to be assigned to a different group than yourself. Working and interacting with new scene/singing partners is an integral part of the learning process in musical theatre.

- No gum or food is to be consumed during class time. There are no exceptions.
